In addition organic growth was high. On a like-for-like basis, and excluding a large, one-off

contract, the Group achieved 5% growth. This was almost identical for each of the various activities of the Group, in the three Electrical Component divisions, as well as in the Advanced Materials and Technologies division.

The outlook for the second half year is good. Orders have risen sharply, benefiting from firmness in the Group's markets and from the amplifying impact of the recent acquisitions on Carbone Lorraine's organic growth.
